Course Information

This **FREE** face to face ESOL course is for eligible adults living in Hampshire aged 19+ who would like to gain skills using English in everyday situations. It will help you to gain confidence and knowledge of English reading, writing, and speaking to help you at home and at work. This course is suitable for people whose English is at Pre-Entry – Entry 1 (Beginner Level A0 / A1) e.g. people who can speak, read or write only a few words in English or maybe none at all. This course will help you to:

- Ask and answer simple questions
- Practice pronunciation
- Understand a simple explanation
- Learn basic English grammar
- Understand a simple instruction
- Practice having a conversation

Commitment

- ✓ You will attend a tutor-led online group session 2 hours a week for 6 weeks
- ✓ You will be offered learning tasks to carry out at home, in your own time
- ✓ You will be offered the opportunity to progress to further learning

Eligibility & Contact Details

There are no formal entry requirements for this course but is most suitable for ESOL learners who are at Beginner ESOL Pre-Entry / Entry (A0/A1).
