It is for people whose English is at Entry 2 / Entry 3 (Pre-Intermediate A2 / B1) This course will help you to:

- Use clear pronunciation
- Understand an explanation
- Learn more about grammar
- Understand instructions
- Take part in discussions

- ✓ You will attend a tutor-led online group session 2 hours a week for 6 weeks
- ✓ You will be offered learning tasks to carry out at home, in your own time
- ✓ You will be offered the opportunity to progress to further learning
