Secure passwords are important when countering cyber security threats. As part of an annual audit of the security of IT systems, we identified that making our passwords stronger would have a positive impact on our data protection and the security of our systems.

All passwords to log into HCC systems that are created from Monday 4 July 2022, will need to have at least 15 characters, and be made up of a minimum of 3 random words. Symbols, numbers, and capital letters can be used to make passwords even stronger.

Passwords that are currently in use will remain as they are for the time being, but after 4 July, at any point where a password expires or needs to be reset, your new password will be required to have the new format.

The random words making up your password must not be guessable or relate to you personally, or at work. For example, 'HampshireCountyCouncil' is guessable. 'Happybirthdaytome' is guessable. More information on choosing a secure password can be found on the Password Policy and Guidance page.
