Course Information

This **FREE** online course is aimed at adults living in Hampshire aged 19+ who would like to develop their knowledge and skills of English reading skills. This course will also prepare you for the functional skills curriculum if you do not currently have a Level 2 English qualification. The course will include the following:

- How to recognise the purpose of different styles of writing
- How to recognise the audience a piece of writing is aimed at
- How to use skimming & scanning to find a piece of information when reading
- How to find language features and presentational features in a text
- How to find positive and negative bias in written texts.

Commitment

- ✓ You will attend a tutor-led online group session 2 hours a week for 6 weeks
- ✓ You will be offered learning tasks to carry out at home, in your own time
- ✓ You will be offered the opportunity to progress to further learning

Eligibility & Contact Details

There are no formal entry requirements for this course but is not intended as an ESOL programme. You will need access to a suitable device with a camera and microphone.
