Continuous Professional Development - more than you think

The CPD activities that you engage in should be appropriate and beneficial to you, and more than a certificate – they should be informing your practice.

CPD is most effective when reflectively planned, this could be accessing development opportunities following an observation or review of practice, self-reflection to identify knowledge gaps, a response to learners needs, or pedagogical up-dating.

CPD is far more than attending a course/workshop

It includes other activities such as

- Mandatory training safeguarding, prevent, British values, GDPR
- Mentoring 1:1 support meeting
- Networking meeting with other tutors, exchanging ideas and discussing key themes
- Observation being observed and observing others
- Reading articles, research, case studies
- Standardisation meetings
- Use of media Podcasts, documentaries
- Workplace shadowing

Under leadership and management inspectors will look to see

 whether continuing professional development for teachers, trainers and other staff is aligned with the curriculum, and the extent to which this develops teachers' subject expertise and pedagogical knowledge over time, so that they deliver high-quality education and training

Teaching Professional Standards

CPD is a key element of the teaching professional standards, so much so that a whole section of the standards is dedicated to it.

Professional Knowledge and Understanding

- 8. Develop and update knowledge of your subject specialism, taking account of new practices, research and/ or industry requirements.
- 9. Critically review and apply your knowledge of educational research, pedagogy, and assessment to develop evidence-informed practice.



- 10. Share and update knowledge of effective practice with colleagues, networks and/or research communities to support improvement.
- 11. Develop and apply your knowledge of special educational needs and disabilities to create inclusive learning experiences.
- 12. Understand your teaching role and responsibilities and how these are influenced by legal, regulatory, institutional and ethical contexts.

It is important to keep a record of the CPD you have completed, including any changes to practice you will be making. There is an example record attached to this update. Our CPS records run on a calendar year in line with the valuing performance cycle.

You will be asked to share your CPD record at any Valuing Performance meetings, EQA visits and to submit this annually to the Quality Team in January.
