Mandatory training:

All tutors are expected to complete annual training in Safeguarding, PREVENT and British Values

- **Safeguarding** training: The course we would currently recommend is from the same organisation as the Prevent training Education and Training Foundation and can be accessed <u>here</u>. If you are an HCC employee, then you can also access safeguarding training via the Learning Zone.
- **PREVENT** training: Prevent training can be accessed through Education and Training Foundation or Home Office Prevent training. Links to these can be found on the VLE. These are free external courses which provide a certificate at the end.
- **British Values**: We offer two paths for training with British values, an on demand online course from our VLE and virtual workshops throughout the year.
