- 1. A learner who came to the UK on the Homes for Ukraine Scheme started learning English with Hampshire Achieves at Entry level (Beginner ESOL). She has now secured employment as a teaching assistant. Firstly, this was on a zero-hour contract, but she's delighted that she's now in full time employment in a primary school helping many Ukrainian children.
- 2. An Afghan lady who had no English reading or writing skills attended an ESOL class with Hampshire Achieves. She developed the confidence to join an ESOL course at College from September 2024. She still attends an ESOL classes with Hampshire Achieves and has now learnt the alphabet and to read basic CVC words. CVC words are words created using a consonant, vowel, and a consonant. Such as 'new', 'hat', 'cot', 'cat' etc. She is improving her writing and reading through practice and perseverance.
