Learner 1: A woman with no prior experience using ICT devices beyond a phone set up by her son. Having been out of work for a considerable time, she also lacked a CV. Initially assessed as "an absolute beginner," she made remarkable progress throughout the course. By the end, she had developed essential digital skills, sent and received her first emails independently, and created a well-structured CV that she felt confident would support her job search efforts.

Learner 2: An older Ukrainian man who had been in the UK for less than a year and was attending ESOL courses to improve his English language skills. Despite having extensive experience in engineering and mining, his original CV was poorly written, making it difficult to read and failing to showcase his skills effectively. By the end of the course, he was thrilled with a fully updated and professionally revised CV, which he believed would significantly enhance his chances of securing suitable employment.

Learner 3: Although this individual had 10 years of continuous work experience, he felt that his CV did not adequately showcase the key skills he had developed during his career. He also lacked confidence in including his interests and hobbies. After revising his CV, refining his personal profile, and highlighting his key skills, he expressed delight with the updated document and began using it immediately.

Learner 4: Despite having attended several Job Clubs and Digital Skills courses, this individual was eager to enhance the personal profile section of his CV. He was introduced to AI tools such as ChatGPT and Microsoft Copilot and learned how they could be used to improve written content. Using these tools, he successfully revised his personal profile and expressed great satisfaction with the result, believing it would strengthen his chances of securing employment.
