Please note that these courses are free to those who are delivering courses for HA DfE funded provision only <u>and HA directly</u> <u>employed tutors</u>, those not delivering on this provision will be charged for attendance. This will be checked using our MIS system.

Additional workshops may be added as needs arise. Please be aware that workshops that have insufficient numbers may be cancelled or re-scheduled, there will need to be a minimum of 5 people booked on a session for it to run. If you have booked onto a course and find you are unable to attend, then please let us know at least 24 hours beforehand.

Additional training may be added as required to support tutor development.

Mandatory training:

All tutors are expected to complete annual training in Safeguarding, PREVENT and British Values

- **Safeguarding** training: The course we would currently recommend is from the same organisation as the Prevent training Education and Training Foundation and can be accessed <u>here</u>. If you are an HCC employee, then you can also access safeguarding training via the Learning Zone.
- **PREVENT** training: Prevent training can be accessed through Education and Training Foundation or Home Office Prevent training. Links to these can be found on the VLE. These are free external courses which provide a certificate at the end.
- **British Values**: We offer two paths for training with British values, an on demand online course from our VLE and virtual workshops throughout the year.

<u>ProtectUK | Home</u> – counter terrorism support and guidance to effectively protect and prepare. There are free e-learning courses (once registered), including modules on ACT (action counters terrorism) awareness. Those with access to the Learning Zone can also access these courses there.

For tutors who have difficulty accessing online learning material there is a possibility of joining an in person safeguarding induction course with new colleagues from Participation and Lifelong Learning. Please contact Wendy Scott wendy.scott2@hants.gov.uk to discuss.
