

# Course Information

This **FREE** course is aimed at adults living in Hampshire aged 19+ who would like to develop their digital skills in a small, supportive group. Are you completely new to computers and the Internet? This course will help you get started on using a computer and develop your confidence for using your device. You will learn all the basics and the key terms you need to start. The course will include the following:

- Find out about different files and how to create and save them
- Discover how to write and send simple letters and emails
- Develop your internet skills so you can find information and complete online forms
- You do all of this while learning how to keep yourself safe online

## Commitment

- ✓ You will attend a tutor-led group session 2 hours a week for 5 weeks
- ✓ You will be offered learning tasks to carry out at home, in your own time
- ✓ You will be offered the opportunity to progress to further learning
