Hampshire Achieves offers a selection of English, employability and progression courses for Speakers of Other Languages (**ESOL**). 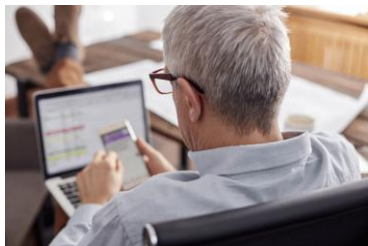
