FREE SECTOR BASED EMPLOYABILITY PROGRAMMES

Hampshire Achieves offers a selection of English, employability and progression courses for Speakers of Other Languages (**ESOL**). We offer various levels, from beginners to advanced, to help you improve your English language skills, to support your children's learning, gain work, advance your career, or prepare you for further academic or vocational study in the UK.

We offer flexible start and finish dates. The usual length of study is 6 weeks and 100% attendance at all sessions is expected. Courses are held **online** via MS Teams and **face to face** in community venues across the county.

ONLINE ESOL – COMPLETE BEGINNERS (ENTRY 1 – AO/A1)



This **free** online course is suitable for people whose English is at Beginner Level e.g. people who can speak, read or write only a few words in English or maybe no English at all. You will learn to ask and answer questions, follow simple instructions and understand an explanation.
