August Success Story - R (Leigh Park)

R first started working with Hampshire Futures in June 2022. After being home educated since 2020, R was very shy and nervous and hadn't had much social interaction due to COVID-19. Whilst working with HF, R's confidence grew and she managed to achieve her Functional Skills Maths and English, something which she had previously been unable to do.

In March 2023, R had an interview with Aspire for a Level 1 Qualification in Childcare, she was successful and finally started at the Nursery in July 2023.

R has come on leaps and bounds since working with HF, She has learnt to take responsibility of herself and the decisions she makes and is now enjoying her new found confidence. Well done R!

CV Tips – What makes a good CV?

Personal Statement

Your personal statement is the first thing an employer reads and an opportunity to personalise your CV. You should briefly summarise what you have achieved in the past, what you hope to achieve in the future, and how the job you're applying for fits that plan.

Check, check, and check again!

Grammar and spelling are really important, so read your CV a few times to make sure there are no mistakes. Why not ask someone else to read it over too?

Be concise

Employers receive tens, if not hundreds, of applications for every job they advertise so make sure your CV is clear, concise, and easy to read. Avoid using jargon or acronyms.

Choose your Template

Tailor your CV to the job

It's important to tailor your CV for each job that you apply for by ensuring that you highlight the most relevant skills and experience.

Don't be shy

Your CV is an opportunity to demonstrate what you're capable of and convince prospective employers that you're right for the job. Don't be afraid to blow your own trumpet!

Length and Presentation

Many employers tend to 'skim' CVs looking for the information that is most relevant and important to them. Keep it to a maximum of two pages and don't use a font size less than 11.

Give examples

Most of us are guilty of having written a CV full of buzzwords like 'teamwork' and 'communication skills' without explaining what we mean by them. Anyone can say they're organised so make sure you give an example to demonstrate how you stand out from the crowd.

The power of google

Many employers admit to 'googling' or searching the names of applicants on social media to see what they can find out! Make sure your online presence is a positive one and if it's not, then consider changing your privacy settings to ensure that you don't leave a negative impression.

Local mental health services partners with Shout

Hampshire and the Isle of Wight's NHS 111 Mental health triage team run by Southern Health NHS Foundation Trust, have partnered with 'Shout' to provide in the moment of mental health support to those in the local community.

People who live in Hampshire and the Isle of Wight can now text 'HANTS' to 85258 to be connected to a trained volunteered who can help with anxiety, stress, loneliness, or depression. The key word 'HANTS' represents an acronym for Help Anytime (even at Night), Text us for Support.

Shout's trained volunteers are there for you **24/7** to listen and support you to get to a calmer and safer place. Shout is a free, confidential, anonymous service for anyone in the UK. It won't show up on your phone bill.

Kooth – Online Counselling for 11-25 year olds.

Kooth is a free, safe, online counselling and emotional wellbeing support service for ages 11- 25. Young people can use the website anonymously to access a range of FREE support including 1:1 text-based counselling, 24h messaging to our team of practitioners, journal and goal setting spaces, support forums and helpful articles on wellbeing and current affairs. Young people can self- refer online at any time by visiting www.kooth.com. Kooth is commissioned primarily by the NHS and is the only digital service of its kind to be accredited by the British Association of Counselling and Psychotherapy.
